OpenAthens Password

For access to many of the resources contained in this guide you will need an NHS OpenAthens password.

How to register:

Visit <https://openathens.nice.org.uk/> preferably from an NHS networked computer. Fill out the online form using an NHS or University email if possible to speed up the authorisation process, and submit. An activation link with your new username will be sent to this email account which will allow you to create a password.

Registering from a home PC is possible but could delay your application by up to 15 days.

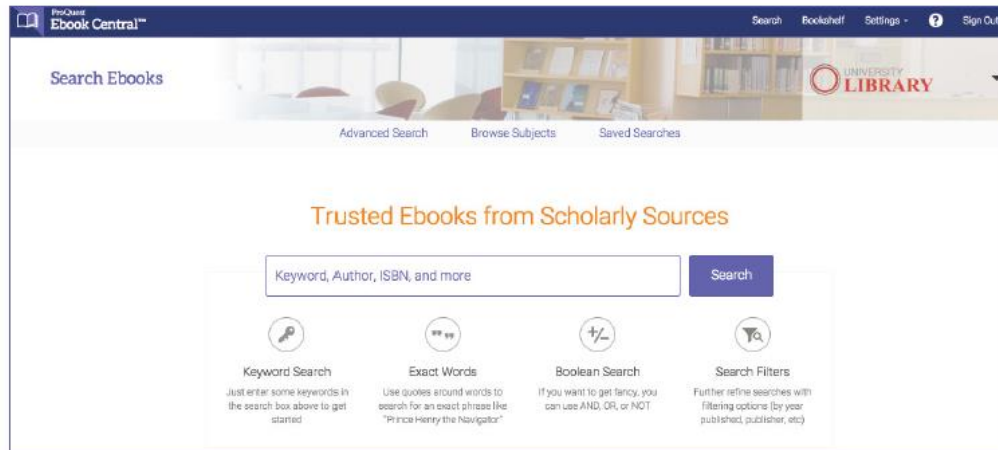


The BNF and BNF for Children aims to provide prescribers, pharmacists, and other healthcare professionals with sound up-to-date information about the use of medicines.

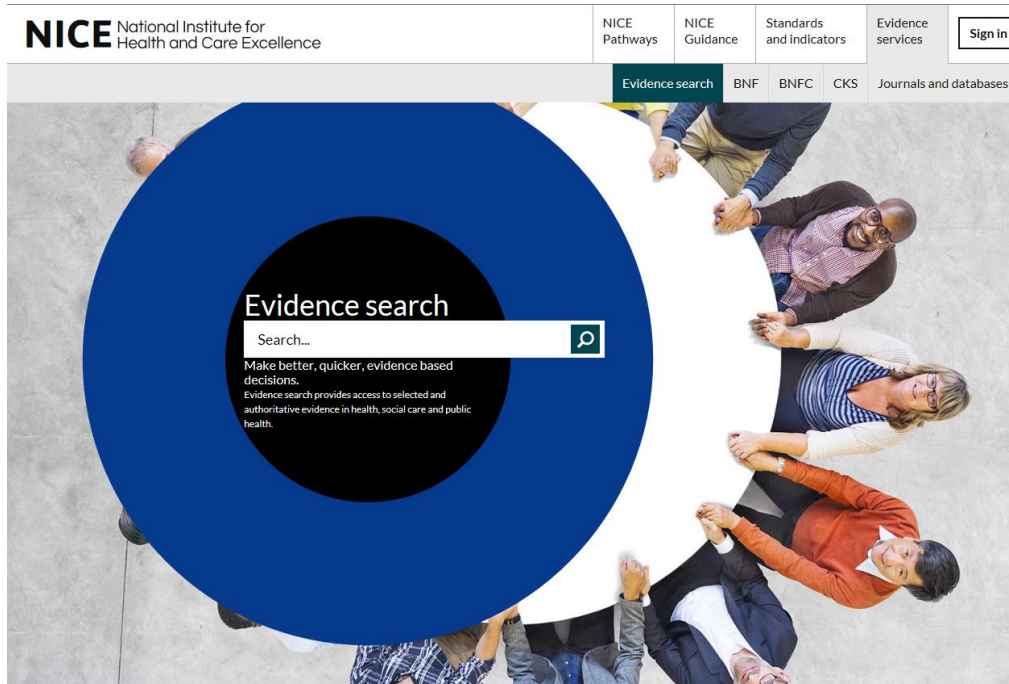
