HSJ, [Two year waiters rise by over 3,000 in a month](#) "The number of patients breaching the two-year mark on the waiting list rose 28 per cent from 9,754 to a record 12,491 between August and September"

Association of Ambulance Chief Executives, [Delayed hospital handovers: impact assessment of patient harm](#) "This report, based on a structured clinical review of handover delays at hospital emergency departments across England, finds that the proportion of patients who could be experiencing unacceptable levels of preventable harm is significant. More than eight in 10 of those whose 'handover' (from ambulance clinician to hospital clinician) was delayed beyond 60 minutes were assessed as having potentially experienced some level of harm; 53 per cent low



harm, 23 per cent moderate harm and 9 per cent (one patient in 10) could have been said to have experienced severe harm.”

Men’s Health, [Levelling up men’s health: the case for a men’s health strategy](#) “Across the UK, men’s mental and physical health is unacceptably poor – with around one man in five dying before the age of 65. Covid has worsened the situation with completely disproportionate effects among men. Many services are failing to reach men in time, especially working-age men, even though there are ever more examples of how services can be designed to reach and engage men more effectively. The lesson from other countries is that introducing a men’s health strategy alongside the government’s planned women’s health strategy can change this. This document lays out the case for change.”

An HFMA roundtable, in association with Lexmark, heard how it will affect NHS finance, and how finance managers can support the sustainability agenda.”

ILC, [Money talks: investing in proactive health measures to support health aging](#) “It is known that proactive (preventive health interventions and health promotion) health measures work, are cost-effective and can save lives. However, across the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), on average countries spend just 2.8 per cent of their health budgets on these interventions. In this report, with ILC-Canada, Canada is used as a case study to demonstrate the effectiveness of spending on prevention and health promotion. Canada spends more of its health budget on proactive health measures than any other country in the OECD – at 6 per cent, it’s more than double the OECD average, which has contributed to positive outcomes.”
